- Make sure their child is suitably dressed in uniform.
- Make sure their child is properly equipped with PE kit.
- Support the school's policy for behaviour.
- Attend consultation meetings.
- Support their child in homework activities.
- Make sure a note or phone call of explanation is provided when their child is absent.
- Avoid holidays in term-time.
- Keep the school up-to-date with contact details.
- Be considerate towards members of the local community eg parking considerately in the neighbourhood.
- Work in partnership with the school to celebrate difference.
- Ensure only water and fruit are brought in as break time snacks.
- Ensure their child follows the rules and regulations of social networking sites such as Facebook where members must be aged 13+.
- Speak to school staff directly regarding any concerns and ensure no adverse comments are posted on social media sites.
