Dear Parents and Carers,

Yesterday it was a real pleasure to take our Years 4,5 and 6 children to Bradford to find out more about different faiths. We visited the Bradford Synagogue and the Gurdwara Singh Sabha Sikh temple. The children asked excellent questions in both places of worship and we are grateful to Mr Lawrence Sacks and Mr Narinder Singh for being so generous with their time and really helping us understand key aspects of the religion. We went on to visit the National Science and Media Museum. It was really magical to see 61 children reach out and try to touch the images which appeared to float in the air before their eyes! The children were all brilliantly behaved and a real credit to their families and school.

The "Dream Big" IMAX film showed children how engineers helped create some of the world's most incredible structures such as earthquake proof skyscrapers and bridges which have transformed lives by enabling children to attend school. The children loved spending hands on time in the Wonderlab and saw science in action through a science workshop. I hope all the children enjoyed the opportunity to find out more about how science can change people lives and about different ways of living. I believe education should open our children's eyes to the world around us and I hope this is a trip the children will remember for a very long time. On Thursday (October 25th) children in Year 3 and Year 4 will lead a harvest assembly at Holy Trinity Church at 2.45pm. Please come along if you can. Rev Collings has asked if our children could bring in non-perishable food such as tins or dried food. 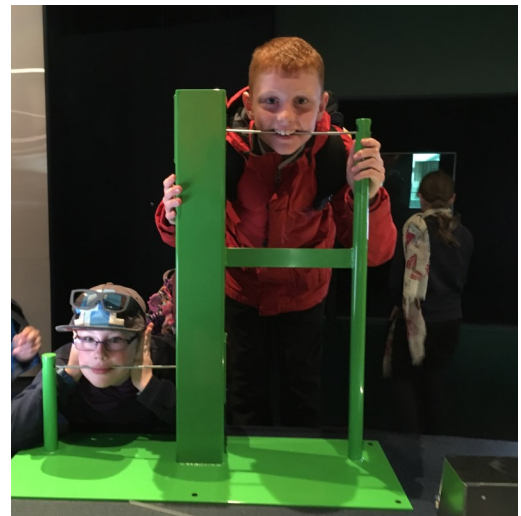
Our new PTA meets next Wednesday!
